## Texas FCCLA

### CONFERENCE ETIQUETTE

THE FOLLOWING IS EXPECTED AT ALL CONFERENCES:

- All students must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.
- Nightwear (pajamas) should not be worn outside of your hotel room. Swimwear and flip flops should only be worn if traveling to/from the pool. A swimwear cover-up must be worn.
- Behavior at all times should reflect a positive, professional image of you, your school, your city, and FCCLA.
- Do not lay on the floors in the hotel hallways.
- Students may not purchase, possess, consume, or be under the influence of alcohol or an illegal drug at any time. Smoking is also prohibited.
- Students of opposite sexes may not be in a hotel room together without an adult to supervise.
- All students should be respectful and considerate during general sessions by refraining from talking and using technology at an inappropriate time.

### Hotel Etiquette

- Meet curfew set by the hotel or advisors
- Do not run around in the halls Keep things neat and tidy, take care of things provided by the hotel in the room.
- Be courteous to hotel staff members
- If swimming in a hotel pool, dress modestly and appropriately. Leave swimsuit coverups on in the hallways.
- Stay in your assigned room
- Respect that you may have people beside and below your room. Don't jump, yell, or hit the walls.

### Elevator Etiquette

- When entering an elevator make sure anyone on the elevator has already exited.
- When multiple people are entering the elevator while you are on, hold the door open button to prevent the door from closing on them.
- Do not stand in front of the doors while waiting for the elevator to prevent people exiting from running into you.
- For your safety, do not stay on the elevator if you are alone and someone else enters.
