STAR Event and State Proficiency Event participants will need to **print the letter containing information for the individual events from the FCCLA website along with the time schedule. Participants will not receive letters via mail.** Please check the website to determine the time that participants will compete. Participants will not attend an orientation, but will go to the assigned area and register for the event by turning in all required materials along with the affiliation confirmation with participants names highlighted. All Events will take place at the Hilton Hotel and the Convention Center except for Culinary Arts and Mystery Basket; competition will be off site.

A list of qualifications for the 2010-2011 regional officer candidates will be posted to the website in January. Please review with your voting delegate the election procedure found in the region constitution and have your voting delegate bring a #2 lead pencil to the House of Delegates session. Each chapter may have one voting delegate in attendance. **The voting delegate badge will be in the registration packet that must be picked up before the House of Delegates session.**

Chapters may turn in contributions to the Region IV Community Service Project on Friday during general registration. See the FCCLA website for specific information about the Community Service Project.

Hotel information is available on the Texas FCCLA website. Curfew is set in the hotel at 11:00 p.m., Thursday and Friday evenings. This means that members should be in their rooms with doors closed and voices should not be heard from the halls or through the walls. Please help enforce this by orienting and monitoring your students.
