## **NOVEMBER 15 APPROACHING**

Affiliation dues must be paid and posted in the system in order for chapters to have members in STAR and Proficiency Events. Be sure to check the system and if you have mailed payment and you do not see it posted, check with national headquarters at 1-800-234-4425.

## **MEMBERSHIP GOAL**

Hats off to Texas FCCLA! We are currently over 22,000 members...more than we had at the end of 2015-16! Remember, you can affiliate additional member until May 31, 2017. Be sure to add new members into the system as you receive them. The officers set a goal to have over 25,000 members this year. Let's Go for the Red Texas!

## **STAR/PROFICIENCY EVENT DEADLINE SOON**

Chapters with members that will participate in STAR and Proficiency Events have until December 1 to get their competitive event payment postmarked. Be sure to watch the calendar and not miss this deadline.....we don't want your student penalized for missing a deadline.

## **COMPETITIVE EVENT GUIDEBOOK**

The edited 2016-17 Competitive Event Guidebook is posted on the Texas website. We will be using the national rules and rubrics; but will also have state guidelines. This will provide consistency between state and national competition.
