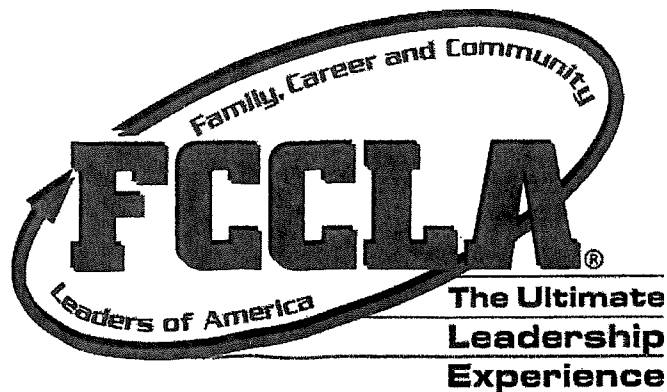

Currently I am involved in the "Ready, Set, Teach!" program at my high school. Four days a week I go into a classroom in an elementary school and assist the teacher in any way that I can. I often work "one on one" with the students that are struggling with learning the material. I also do art projects with them to help better develop their motor skills as well as build a relationship with each and every student.

As the Vice President of Service Learning, I work to ensure we do lots of projects to help the community. Last year, our chapter helped prepare a meal for the firefighters in honor of their service. We made spaghetti with breadsticks and a side salad. This past October, our chapter set up a reading session for children at our public library. We read two books and had the children draw two pictures about the story. We were collaborating with them while they were drawing and even drew with them.

At my high school we have a club called Clemens Broadcasting Network (CBN). Each week we create two, six minute episodes, one regular and one sports edition. We announce things like PSAs, upcoming events, and even help promote other clubs. All members of CBN are handpicked by the sponsor. In order to be considered, you must first take either Digital Media or Audio Video as an elective. Based on the quality of work performed in these classes, the sponsor then decides whether or not you will get to participate in next year's CBN. It is a very selective yet amazing organization and I am so appreciative to have been given the opportunity to participate in it.
