APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications should be completed in full and returned to the Association, which will carry out the application process, evaluation procedure and determination of recipients of the scholarships awarded.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible a student must:

- Be a resident of the state of Texas
- Be a 2017 graduate of a Texas high school
- Have an overall high school grade average of 85
- Be a Texas regional or state officer
- Have been an active member of an affiliated chapter of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America for at least one year.
- Meet entrance requirements of Texas college or university which offers a degree in family and consumer sciences
- Enroll in a Texas accredited college with a family and consumer sciences department in the fall of 2012
- **MAJOR IN ANY AREA OF FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCES**
- Include test scores of American College Testing (ACT) and/or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)
- Submit one typed copy of the application form, transcript of grades for last grading period, and two letters of recommendation.
- Attach two copies of an autobiography

RECEIVING THE SCHOLARSHIP

To be awarded the Texas Farm Bureau scholarship, the winner of the must attend the Texas FCCLA State Leadership Conference in April held in Corpus Christi. In the event the winner does not attend, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate winner.
